



## Broadstone Warren Scout Site and Activity Centre Naturalist Badge 2010



In 2010 there will be a Naturalist Badge course run at Broadstone Warren on 16<sup>th</sup> until 18<sup>th</sup> February.

The course will consist of a mixture of classroom and field based sessions that include taught lessons, discussions and student led investigations both as part of a group and as an individual. All field based work will take place on site at Broadstone Warren.

Registration for the course commences from 6.30pm on the Tuesday evening, and the course starts at 7pm. The course concludes on Thursday at 3.30pm with a presentation. Parents and carers are invited to attend this.

The cost of the weekend will be £40.00 per person, and this will cover indoor accommodation, all tuition, food and equipment.

The Naturalist Badge that is run by Broadstone Warren is an intensive course that involves hard work of a physical nature, and is not suitable for younger Scouts. As a result all participants must be at least 11 years of age.

At the end of the course, successful participants will be awarded with a certificate. The badge will be awarded by your Scout Leader. Any participant who does not complete the course will be informed of how they need to improve before the badge can be awarded.

Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. There are thirty places on the course. Only completed forms which include payment will be accepted.
